Reminder that St. Mary's Church will be closed this Thursday and Friday, but Our Lady, Queen of Peace Church will remain open for personal prayer, outside of Masses, during the week from 9:00am to 6:30pm.

The number permitted to attend funerals is now restricted to **10 mourners**.
